

To prepare for a successful study program in France, here are some essential documents we highly recommend you to bring with you. Bring also photocopies and/or certified copies. If necessary, have your documents **translated into French**.

1. Documents

- Valid passport
- Visa
- Extract of birth certificate (original and a minimum of 3 copies: 1 for the residence permit, 1 for the Office of Student Affairs, 1 for the housing subsidies)
- Proof of financial resources
- Certificate of enrolment
- Diplomas obtained in your country of origin or certified copies
- Transcripts of your last two years at school
- Identity photographs (not scanned, regular portrait size 4.5 x 4.5 cm, no colored background, bare-headed, no hats)
- Vaccination booklet
- Health insurance
- Prescriptions, if you are under special treatment

2. If you are married and your spouse comes with you

- Marriage certificate, translated into French and certified
- Same documents as for yourself

3. If you have children

- Extracts of birth certificates (if necessary, translated into French and certified)
- Vaccination booklet

4. We also advise you to bring

- A sufficient amount in Euros to meet your immediate needs
- Clothes adapted to the French climate in your carry-on luggage
