Education Related Expenditures

Academic expenditures (books, etc...)	•€300 - €600
Laptop & printer (optional)	•€500 - €1,000

Fee Payment Schedule

If offered a place on the Global MBA program, you will be given a deadline by which you should secure your seat by paying a non-refundable deposit (or first installment of the program fees) totaling €5,000.

Estimated Cost Living in France and Singapore

Rent and other living expenses vary considerably depending on the participant's family situation, lifestyle choices and financial means. A survey of ESSEC students shows that a single participant can expect to incur the following basic expenses during the twelve month program. To this, add an increase of approximately 25% if you are coming with your partner.
