ESSEC Business School, one of the world's leading international business schools, has the pleasure to announce the call for applications for the *ESSEC USA Alumni International Leadership Award - Philippe Mathé Fellowship*, which has been granted by the USA Chapter of the ESSEC Business School Alumni Association for many years.

The *Philippe Mathé Fellowship* is designed to offer qualified candidates the opportunity to supplement their North American undergraduate experience with higher education at ESSEC's campuses in France and Singapore.

The USA Chapter of the ESSEC Alumni Association awards two merit scholarships annually. The value of the *Philippe Mathé Fellowship* is € 5,000.

The *Philippe Mathé Fellowship* is not mutually exclusive of any other scholarships obtained by the candidate.

To be considered for the *Philippe Mathé Fellowship*, applicants need to:

- Be a US, Canadian, or Mexican citizen, AND/OR be enrolled in or have graduated from a US, Canadian, or Mexican university AND/OR have significant and successful work experience in the United States, Canada, or Mexico;
- Meet the regular standards for admission in one of the qualifying ESSEC Programs;
- Submit a personal essay on international leadership, explaining <u>how the unique</u> experience of graduate business study at ESSEC will help realize their personal and <u>professional goals.</u>
- Submit two reference letters
- Submit a copy of their GMAT or GRE scores

In order to apply for the *Philippe Mathé Fellowship*, candidates should submit their completed application form with their personal essay.

The deadline for applications for the 2019 intake is **March 15, 2019**.

Scholarship winners will be contacted approximately 21 days after the application deadline.
