- Be enrolled or have graduated from a US, Canadian, or Mexican university and/or have significant and successful work experience in the United States, Canada, or Mexico;
- Meet the regular standards for admission in the relevant ESSEC Program;
- Submit a personal essay on international leadership, explaining how the unique experience of graduate business study at ESSEC will help realize their personal and professional goals.
- Submit two reference letters
- Submit a copy of their GMAT scores

In order to apply for the *Philippe Mathé Fellowship*, candidates should submit their completed application form with their personal essay.

The deadline for applications for the 2018 intake is **June 10, 2018**.

Scholarship winners will be contacted approximately 30 days after the application deadline.
