The “International Leadership Award-Philippe Mathé Fellowship” was established by the alumni association in the USA in 2009 and has already awarded 16 scholarships worth 5,000 euro each. This is funded by generous donations from the alumni community in the USA.

This merit scholarship is designed to offer qualified candidates the opportunity to supplement their North American undergraduate experience with higher education at ESSEC in France.

Value: the merit Scholarship is a single payment of 5,000 EURO going towards tuition payment and paid directly to the school. It can be combined with other scholarships.

Eligibility:

To be considered for the ESSEC USA scholarship programme, applicants need to:

- Be enrolled or have graduated from a USA or Canadian University.
- Have significant and successful work experience in North America.
- Meet the regular standards for admission to the master’s program of their choice.
- Submit a personal essay on International Leadership, explaining how the unique experience of graduate business study at ESSEC will help realize your personal and professional goals. 900 words or three pages maximum in length.

Application:

Applications have to be sent to the ESSEC registrar’s office at registraire@essec.edu:

- Application form
- Copy of bachelor’s degree with transcript
- Resume
- Personal essay on International Leadership
- Two letters of reference

The registrar office will confirm you are a candidate and send a copy of your application.

The deadline for applications for 2022 admissions is: **15 June 2022**
